School Instrument Rental Agreement

Students using a school-owned wind, percussion, string, and/or electronic instrument are required to pay a nominal rental fee for the school year. This fee has become a necessity due to wear and tear and the high cost of instrument replacement. It is also intended to give the student a sense of ownership and responsibility for the instrument.

Instruments will be assigned by the director and recorded by serial number. Upon signing this form, the student assumes responsibility for the proper care and maintenance of his or her instrument. All percussionists are responsible for <u>all</u> percussion equipment (including marching equipment, concert drums, mallet instruments, auxiliary equipment, toys, sticks, and mallets). Students are expected to care for the instrument as if it was their own. This includes REGULAR oiling of valves, greasing of corks and slides, and removal of water from the instrument (swabbing the bore, emptying water keys, etc.). **Any damage to the instrument MUST BE REPORTED TO MR. LEVIN IMMEDIATELY.** Any repairs from the result of normal wear and tear on the instrument (pad wears out, etc.) are covered by the school. Any repairs from the result of neglect or flagrant misuse will be covered by the student and his/her family. As a result of such mistreatment, the student may lose the privilege of using the school instrument and will not receive a refund for the rental cost of the instrument. Mr. Levin reserves the final say as to who is responsible for the instrument repair costs. Repairs will only be completed by technicians approved by Mr. Levin. Instruments are rented in the best condition possible. Any previous damage should be noted on this form upon signing. The director reserves the right to use any school owned instrument for teaching purposes at the school (with proper cleaning).

Instruments must be returned in the same condition in which they were originally rented less normal wear and tear. Instruments must be cleaned and lubricated before returns will be accepted. Students can be encumbered for failure to return all instrument parts in the proper condition.
